Staff-level .NET engineer who owns platform architecture end to end, from REST API design through the deployment pipeline it ships on. Twelve years full stack .NET and seven fully remote, most recently the first lead-level engineering hire at Storee, a 200-person firm, where I set the architecture, built the team, and consolidated four applications onto a single .NET 9 platform on Azure without interrupting production releases. I work in secure, regulated environments, and the code review, testing and release standards I set are what make that pace repeatable.

- Four ASP.NET applications and one platform: consolidated the entire application estate of a 200-person construction firm onto a unified .NET 9 platform on Azure as its first lead-level engineering hire, choosing the target architecture, the migration strategy and the delivery standards the team still works to
- Directed cross-functional delivery across internal teams, third-party IT partners, contractors, QA, and executive stakeholders, and kept production releases consistent on a high-risk legacy platform by removing blockers, reprioritizing work, and giving clear technical direction
- Improved data architecture and system reliability by transitioning from stored procedure-driven access to Entity Framework and implementing database integrity controls, reducing data inconsistencies and improving development velocity
- Reduced release cycle time by 50% through code reviews, testing workflows, release controls, and technical documentation, establishing a repeatable, auditable delivery process for high-accountability environments
- Designed the REST API layer and built the React and TypeScript front end on the consolidated platform, replacing the separate interfaces the four legacy applications carried, and defined the Azure infrastructure in Bicep so I built every environment from source control
- Ran a phased Strangler Fig migration that replaced legacy components a piece at a time, holding the release schedule through the whole migration, and moved the platform onto Clean ("Onion") architecture
- Hired and mentored a four-person engineering team, ran the technical interviews and onboarded each engineer, and set the bar for architecture and code quality
- Recorded architecture decisions in writing so disagreements resolved through a documented tradeoff rather than through seniority, giving a four-person team a standard to build against rather than a person to ask

- Cut \$30,000+ from Azure and third-party spend through infrastructure optimization and vendor coordination
- Implemented SSO with Auth0 and enforced MFA/2FA across client-facing applications, which shortened client onboarding and tightened authentication security
- Modernized the platform from .NET Framework to .NET 6 and moved the front end to TypeScript, which ended the firm's exposure to framework deprecations

2026 to Present

- Built a React and TypeScript front end over a .NET 10 REST API with parameter-driven search and detail views, covered by unit, component and end-to-end suites running in CI on every push
- Ran the same application on two stores at once, Azure SQL Database through EF Core and Azure Cosmos DB through its SDK, behind one set of async ports, with an account modelled as one document plus one address document so an email stays unique without a cross-partition unique index
- Kept every credential out of the design: the SQL server is Entra-only, the Cosmos account has no keys, and the container reaches both as its own managed identity
- Proved both stores perform the same with a benchmark the app runs on itself, alternating which store goes first on paired requests, so the numbers show the round trip rather than the engine
- Hand-authored a multi-stage Dockerfile, published the image to Azure Container Registry, and ran it on Azure Container Instances from a container spec the deploy pipeline rolls, with the production target written in Azure Bicep
- Owned the data model, the search and indexing strategy, and the rule that serializes simultaneous bids, and built it with test driven development (TDD), every test specified before Claude Code implemented against it, under 76 decision records and 502 xUnit, 110 Vitest and 66 Playwright tests
- Built a .NET 10 minimal API with OpenAPI, JWT bearer authentication, LINQ server-side filtering, Application Insights telemetry through Azure Monitor OpenTelemetry, and integration tests against both live stores before release
